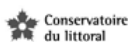
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PRACTICES AND TOOLS FOR INTEGRATED PLANNING OF COASTAL AREAS

❖ **Doing by learning**

- ✓ Adoption of the ICZM Protocol is first step - force implementation through practical interventions – Action Plan for the ICZM Protocol implementation - project and programme based actions

❖ **Integration and concerted efforts/responses**

Sea and Land Integration – comprehensiveness, but also brings plenty opportunities

- ✓ **Methodology for territorial planning and marine space planning**- multidisciplinary approach-comprehensive data set and prioritization are needed – recognition of the problems and cartographic presentation of related data and analysis/sensitivity of marine space - **land and marine data together enable better data and provide good practices**
 - ✓ **MSP data assets integration with IMAP/EcAp – MSP integration with MFSD**
 - ✓ A number of **MSP advantages** - no private property, legal aspects go faster, ...
 - ✓ **MSP and ICZM need to be integrated** into global **sustainable development policy** - MSP and ICZM choices and options need to be integrated into mid and long term national/local sustainable development policies
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Integrated scales for ICZM implementation

- ✓ **ICZM implementation is complicated** for practical implementation, especially at local scale
- ✓ ICZM enables to work with various scales and groups - **ICZM is a forcing drive for a coast**
- ✓ Integrate sea uses mostly conflicting each other-integrate social and economic impacts within sea use planning, e.g. integrated tourism and nature approach - integrate impacts of coastal anthropogenization in process of looking for MSP responses - **concrete tools are needed to support integration**
- ✓ **Integration through participation**
- ✓ Integration through **concerted governance responses** - from observation to regulation
